Security

Allow at least 15 minutes to go through security when entering legislative buildings. **A photo ID is required** to enter the buildings. Food and cameras are prohibited. Cell phones must be turned off.

Dress

Wear warm, comfortable clothes and shoes for walking.

Snow/Inclement Weather Plan

This event will be held unless state government offices are closed for snow or inclement weather.

Parking and Shuttle

Parking at the Navy-Marine Corps Stadium off Rowe Blvd. is \$5 per day. The **State Shuttle** (trolley) runs to the legislative complex every 5–15 minutes. Get off at the Legislative Services stop (the stop after the Governor's Mansion). Cross College Avenue and walk about one-half block on Bladen Street. The entrance to the Miller Senate Office Building will be on the left.
